




PRARE FAITH COMPANION

A Message from Pastor Jon



John 12-1-8-"¹ Six days before the Passover Jesus came to Bethany, the home of Lazarus, whom he had raised from the dead. ² There they gave a dinner for him. Martha served, and Lazarus was one of those at the table with him. ³ Mary took a pound of costly perfume made of pure nard, anointed Jesus' feet, and wiped them with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume. ⁴ But Judas Iscariot, one of his disciples (the one who was about to betray him), said, ⁵ "Why was this perfume not sold for three hundred denarii and the money given to the poor?" ⁶ (He said this not because he cared about the poor, but because he was a thief; he kept the common purse and used to steal what was put into it.) ⁷ Jesus said, "Leave her alone. She bought it so that she might keep it for the day of my burial. ⁸ You always have the poor with you, but you do not always have me."

This year the month of April is equally divided into a time of sorrow and a time of celebration. April 6th is the 5th Sunday in Lent, when we remember how Jesus was anointed by Mary in preparation for His burial. The entire Lenten season is a reflection on Jesus' coming death and the necessity for it-our sinfulness, resulting in the need for redemption. There is a brief note of joy on April 12th, Palm Sunday, as Jesus rides into Jerusalem to shouts of "Hosanna"-but the mood quickly changes as Jesus is betrayed, arrested, and led to His death. Then on April 20th the mood changes from sorrow to celebration, as we remember Jesus' resurrection with joy, and the joy continues the following Sunday, as we recall Jesus' joyful reunion with His disciples. This April we are reminded that throughout our lives, as in Jesus' life, there will be times of great sorrow and great joy-but whether we are crying "Have mercy", "Hosanna", or "Hallelujah", God has promised to be with us through it all, and this we can count on through all the seasons of our lives. May the remainder of the Lenten season prepare you to celebrate the joyous Easter that follows and may God's peace be with you. *Pastor Jon*
