# **PFSM Council February Meeting**

The February 6, 2024 meeting of Prairie Faith Shared Ministry Council was held at Bethlehem Church library in WaKeeney.

The following churches and representatives were in attendance: Bethlehem – Richard Jensen, Margaret Schmitt; St. John – Bob Schonthaler; Emanuel – Kathleen Fabrizius. Also in attendance was Pastor Jon Anderson. Called to order by President Bob.

Devotions were given by Richard.

An agenda, minutes and financial packet was given to all attendees. Minutes from the December 12, 2023 meeting were accepted as presented.

Richard gave the report on the financial packet. Treasurers report was approved as presented.

Pastor Jon reported that Lenten Season is starting, February 14 is Ash Wednesday and there will be a service at BLC at 6 p.m. and St. John's at 8 p.m. Maundy Thursday services will be held at BLC at 6 p.m. and St. John's at 8 p.m. Pastor Jon will be taking vacation beginning April 6<sup>th</sup> and he suggested that a combined service be held on April 7<sup>th</sup> with Ethan Feistner filling the pulpit. The service will be held on April 7<sup>th</sup> at BLC at 10:30 with potluck following. The new Covenant and budget was passed at all congregational meetings. Next step is to appoint a call committee from all three churches and then the Synod will come and do an orientation. After that the profile will need to be put together about PFSM, the churches and the communities. Each church needs to be asked for volunteers to serve on Call Committee, possibly 2 from each church and an alternate.

Pastor Jon would also like to host a site for discussion on what we want in a new bishop as the current Bishop is retiring in 2025.

The call process was discussed.

Nancy submitted a written report for the Parish Nurse to the council. Please give Nancy any feedback or ideas on the Parish Nurse program.

Communications: A thank you note was received from Pastor Jon.

Old Business: None.

New Business: Richard presented a proposal for an office professional. A contract position would be created to move Gail into a more permanent position. The contract would be just to manage the office. If Gail is gone and she finds someone to take those duties it would be paid out of the contract wage we pay Gail. PFSM agreed to do the contract with Gail for Office Management.

Next meeting will be April 9th, 2024 at 7:30 p.m. at Bethlehem Library and Kathleen will have devotions.

Meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.

In the month of May, there is much to celebrate, and many of the celebrations start with the letter "M". We celebrate milestones-confirmations at Bethlehem and St. John, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade, high school, and college graduations. We celebrate mothers on May 12<sup>th</sup> (the same day we celebrate three confirmations at St. John). And on May 27<sup>th</sup> we celebrate Memorial Day, when we remember with thanksgiving the lives of our beloved friends and relatives who have gone before us and are at rest, especially those who fought and died in service to our country. The church year includes other celebrations this month that don't start with "M"-on May 8<sup>th</sup> we celebrate Jesus' ascension into heaven; on May 19<sup>th</sup> we celebrate the Day of Pentecost when the Holy Spirit descended on the Church (the same day we celebrate a combined baptism and confirmation at Bethlehem). Each Sunday in May, no matter what else is going on or being celebrated, we will be celebrating the presence of God among us in Word and Sacrament, giving us forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation. All of these celebrations draw us to thank God-to thank God that He has brought people to important milestones; that He has given us mothers to love and nurture us; and people whose memories we cherish. It's May-it's time to celebrate and rejoice, and give thanks to God.
